### **Campaign Update**

I'm wrapping up my neighborhood campaigning, having visited each and every one of the streets in District 1. I've reached out to nearly 2000 homeowners and spoken with approximately 1500 citizens and feel very prepared to represent this district as your next Supervisor.

On June 22, the York County Registrar declared me the uncontested candidate for York County, District 1, Board of Supervisor position in the November 2023 election.

I thank everyone who has supported me in this effort, and I look forward to serving you.

### **York County Comprehensive Plan**

The York County Planning Commission reviewed the draft 2040 Comprehensive Plan during its regular meeting on June 14<sup>th</sup>. A workshop was then held on June 22<sup>nd</sup> to address concerns raised by citizens at the June 14<sup>th</sup> meeting of the

Commission, as well as issues raised by the Planning Commission.

A follow-up meeting of the Commission is scheduled for August 9<sup>th</sup> to allow citizens a final opportunity to raise questions or concerns before the Planning Commission. Following that meeting, the draft 2040 Comprehensive Plan will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors with a recommendation.

## **Absentee and Early Voting**

For absentee ballots, an upcoming change to the process will require voters to provide their driver's license number and the last 4 digits of their SSN. Voters are no longer required to provide a reason for requesting an absentee ballot.

The York County Registrar will mail out absentee ballots on or before September 22, and in-person voting will begin on September 22<sup>nd</sup> at both office locations, one of which is in District 1, located at Victory Village (Big Lots and Home Depot location at 6614 Mooretown Rd, Suite A in Williamsburg).
